Best Friend Snacks

The best kinds of friends are the ones that share, and the best kinds of snacks for your Friendship Party are snacks you and your friends can enjoy together! Keep with the Clementine theme by bringing in—what else? clementines for you and your guests! Add other orange foods like orange sherbet, orange lollipops, and orange juice. And don't forget to ask your guests if they have any special food requests, so everyone can enjoy the treats at your event.

Truly Fabulous Decorations

To set the tone for your Friendship Party, pick your favorite color theme (it doesn't have to be orange!), and buy construction paper, streamers, and balloons to get your party ready to go. If I Were Friend of the Week...


When Clementine is named “Friend of the Week,” she is given a series of very important responsibilities she must account for and handle.






Celebrating What I Do Best!

But it's also important to recognize your own strengths, and every once in a while take a moment to acknowledge just what makes YOU special.


