

Story Time at Home

Dinosaur has to learn to use his "inside roar" when he goes to the library, and how to sit still for story time. You can help your child learn both of these things before going to the library by practicing story time at home. You can be the reader, or your child can, or you can read together!

Promotion

- Make signs to put up around the house inviting everyone (stuffed animals included) to story time. Be sure to include the date, time, and where it will be held.

Set-up

- Choose one or two great books to read aloud (don't forget the DINOSAUR VS. books!).
- Set books up next to a chair or pillows where the reader will sit.

Guests

- Set everyone up (family members, toys, etc.) in front of the story time chair.
- Welcome everyone, and remind them to use their inside roars, and to sit quietly during the story.

Story Time

- Read the title and show the cover of each book before reading.
- When done, thank everyone for coming!



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
