



BAYMAX BALLOON CENTERPIECE

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Birthday graphic, printed, 4 copies
- Square cardboard box, 8" square or under
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- White large helium balloons
- Black ribbon
- Metal washers
- Red tissue paper



1. Print four copies of the birthday graphic on a sheet of 8 1/2" x 11" paper. The graphic is sized for an 8" square box. If you are using a smaller box, reduce the size of the graphic to fit the box. Cut out the graphics and glue one graphic to each side of the box.
2. Inflate one to six white balloons with helium and attach black ribbon to them.
3. Tie several metal washers to the bottom of the ribbon to weigh down the balloons. Place the metal washers in the box, adjusting the ribbon around the washers so that the balloons float about 18" to 24" above the box.
4. Fill the box with red tissue paper to hide the bottoms of the ribbon.
5. To draw a Baymax face on each balloon, cut out two 1 1/2" circles and one 1/4" x 3" strip from masking tape. Adhere the two circles in the middle of the balloon about 3" apart, and adhere the thin strip between the two eyes. (If you prefer, you can draw the face with a black permanent marker directly on the balloon instead.)
