

Alphabet banners.

String, twine or

- 1. All 26 letters of the alphabet are provided for you to print. Find the letters for HAPPY BIRTHDAY, as well as the letters to spell out the name of the birthday boy/girl. Print each letter out on 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" white paper or cardstock.
- 2. Cut out each rectangular alphabet flag. Fold each flag $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the top, where indicated.
- 3. Line up the letters to form words with each flag about an inch apart. Run a length of string or ribbon between the folded edges at the top, gluing or stapling each flag in place. Make sure you leave plenty of string on either side that you can use for tying to tables or walls.
- 4. Depending on how much room you have, you may want to break up the banner into multiple banners, splitting up the words HAPPY, BIRTHDAY, and the name.
