HINTS & TIPS

Take the stage on a wild ride to pop-stardom as you help Hannah Montana win her greatest musical challenge yet. Tour the world as the pop star herself while developing musical and fashion skills. To get started, check out these hints and tips!

- ★ After every performance Hannah finds out what her fans thought. Precise dance moves and excellent timing are rewarded with Stars, so it pays to learn how to do the moves and *when* to do them.
- ★ If Hannah doesn't wow her fans in a city she visits the first time, she can return to that Stage to give it another shot to push her Star total up. Once five Stars are earned, the perfect version of the dance choreography is stored. You can watch these by visiting the Review screen, pointing at the "Play" button with the **Wii Remote™** and pressing the **A Button**.
- ★ When Hannah's performances go well, she doesn't have to practice as much, which means she has more time to Go Shopping! Every Star she earns performing is worth three Shopping Bags. Everything Hannah buys fills just one Shopping Bag. Hannah can keep shopping until all her Bags are filled.
- ★ While backstage, Hannah can work out travel details with Jackson. By selecting Perform a Concert, Hannah may return to cities she has previously visited and try to collect stars (and Shopping Bags) she might not have earned the first time. By selecting Go Shopping, Hannah gets to shop.
- ★ Naturally, Hannah's adoring fans want her autograph. During autograph sessions, fans will wave things for her to sign. Use the **Wii Remote** to select an item to sign and then press the **A Button** to autograph it. Don't sign anything silly, or Hannah's pen might not work as well, costing her time with her other fans!
- ★ To begin a songwriting session, look for a highlighted guitar in the Music Store with your **Wii Remote**, and then press **A Button** to select it. Hold your **Nunchuk™** and **Wii Remote** in the guitar pose (**Nunchuk** out to the left, **Wii Remote** at right hip). When the music starts, follow the icons on screen and position the **Nunchuk Control Stick** as indicated while strumming with the **Wii Remote**. Try your best, because if you perform the new song well, it will be available for Hannah's stage show.
- ★ If you ever need to repeat a dance lesson or be reminded how to perform a move, visit Oliver backstage to **Review a Tutorial** or **Practice a Song**.
- ★ In the Dance Off, you and a friend face off on stage in a performance of one, three, or five songs. When the concert ends, the reviewers will reveal their scores and the winner.

BASIC WII REMOTE GESTURES

MORE ADVANCED GESTURES WILL BE TAUGHT TO PLAYERS DURING GAMEPLAY



Wii Remote held upright while “stirring the pot”



Wii Remote thrust up



Wii Remote thrust right



Wii Remote thrust down



Wii Remote flicked forward (like casting a fishing line)



Tap your heart with your **Wii Remote**

BASIC NUNCHUK GESTURES



Nunchuk thrust up



Nunchuk thrust left



Nunchuk thrust down



Tap your heart with your **Nunchuk**



Nunchuk tilted slightly backward and held like a microphone



Nunchuk flick forward (like casting a fishing line)



Nunchuk held upright while “stirring the pot”

COMBINED GESTURES



Nunchuk out to left, **Wii Remote** at right hip as if strumming a guitar



Clapping motion



Nunchuk and **Wii Remote** held upright while “stirring”



Tap your heart with both your **Nunchuk** and your **Wii Remote**



Propel both your **Nunchuk** and **Wii Remote** up



Propel both your **Nunchuk** and **Wii Remote** down

AUDIENCE INTERACTION GESTURES



Wave the **Wii Remote** to get crowd reaction



Thrust the **Wii Remote** up in a “high-five” gesture



Tap the **Wii Remote** out in front of you as if to touch someone’s hand



Make a slight clapping motion with the **Wii Remote** and **Nunchuk**



Use the **Wii Remote** to quickly perform a “high-five” motion three times in the air
