## **ABC Printables**

If you've already hung up letters A-H, you can simply add I-P to that line. Or, you can hang I-P separately – just follow these directions.

**Step 1:** Place the right circle on the letter "I" page over the left circle on letter "J". Push a brad clip through the circles and secure in back to link the two pages together. Repeat through "P" to link all the pages together. (Brad clips are available at Joann's or Michaels.)

**Step 2:** Pull string, yarn, or fishing line through the left circle on the "I" page. Do the same for the right circle on the "P" page.

**Step 3:** Hang in your child's room, or around the house.



## Other activities for letters

- Print your child's letter ("J" for "Jake") and affix it to his bedroom door.
- Tape a photo of something related to each letter to the back of its page (example: a photo of you for "M", as in "Mother") to help create an association between letter and object.
