



## FACT SHEET

Museum Mission:	The Walt Disney Family Museum presents the life and achievements of the man who raised animation to an art, transformed the film industry, tirelessly pursued innovation, and created a global and distinctively American legacy.
Museum Exhibits:	The Museum tells Disney's story in his own words and those of his family, friends, and co-workers. Using a mix of historic materials and artifacts, Disney's achievements have come to life through innovative displays that include listening stations, interactive media, and more than 200 video monitors. Much of the material is being generously lent by the Walt Disney Company and private collectors.
Hours:	The museum is open 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., Wednesdays through Mondays. The museum is closed on Tuesdays, January 1, July 4, Thanksgiving Day, and December 25.
Admission:	Admission is by timed-entry ticket, which can be purchased up to 60 days in advance online. Tickets are \$20 for adults, \$15 for seniors and students, and \$12.50 for children 6 to 17. Admission is free for members.

Location:	The Presidio of San Francisco, part of the Golden Gate National Recreation Area of the National Park Service.
Facilities:	<p>The Walt Disney Family Museum has renovated and upgraded three existing buildings on the Presidio's Main Post. The principal building, at 104 Montgomery Street, faces the Parade Ground.
