Museum Mission:

The Walt Disney Family Museum presents the life and achievements of the man who raised animation to an art, transformed the film industry, tirelessly pursued innovation, and created a global and distinctly American legacy.

Museum Exhibits:

The Museum tells Disney's story in his own words and those of his family, friends, and co-workers. Using a mix of historic materials and artifacts, Disney's achievements will come to life through innovative displays that include listening stations, interactive media, and more than 200 video monitors. Much of the material is being generously lent by the Walt Disney Company and private collectors.

Location: The Presidio of San Francisco, part of the Golden Gate National Recreation Area

Facilities: The Walt Disney Family Museum is renovating and upgrading three existing buildings on the Presidio's Main Post. The principal building, at 104 Montgomery Street, faces the Parade Ground. The total area of the three buildings is 77,000 square feet and includes:

A former barracks:

- Main exhibit galleries (10 galleries)
- 123-seat screening facility
- Learning center
- 1,100 square foot Museum Store
- Café

A former gymnasium:

- Museum and Foundation offices and collections
- Beginning in 2011: 2,000 square foot gallery for special exhibitions

A former storage shed:

- Equipment room
