## FOOD

Get into the spirit by providing a variety of snacks inspired by the ancient Greeks and Romans, and the gods themselves!

### Ideas:

- Take modern snacks and give them a Greek or Roman identity (malt balls as “quails eggs” or pizza rolls as “baked sheep livers”). Label each dish with its chosen Greek or Roman name.
- Take a favorite drink and make it your signature Greek ambrosia to serve to your guests. This could be a sports drink, lemonade, or best of all, make your own Greek-inspired concoction!
- Add some authentic flavor with traditional hors d’oeuvres inspired by Ancient Greece such as baklava, goat cheese with honey, or pita bread bites!

## FASHION:

Invite your guests to really get into the Greek and Roman theme by wearing traditional garb to your party!

Keep in mind some of the traditional Greek and Roman dress staples: togas, soldiers’ armor, gladiator apparel, tunics, peplos, chitons.

## DECORATIONS:

Divide your guests into groups and decorate the space for your party with images of the architecture and engineering accomplishments of the Greco-Roman world.

Typical themes in Greek architecture included: columns, porticos, statuary, friezes, mosaics and frescoes. To this the Romans added arches, domes, aqueducts, paved roads, and a timeless construction material, and cement.
