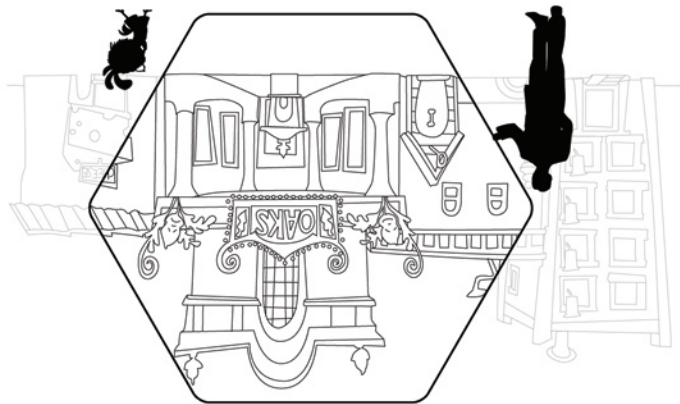




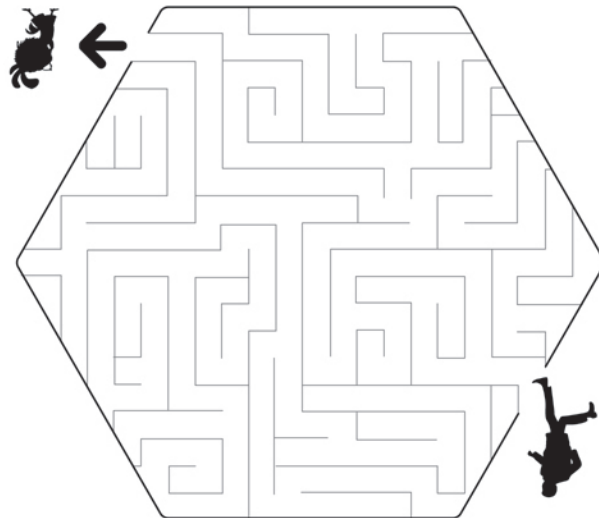

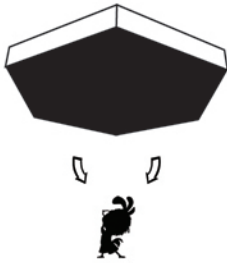


Step 2
Gearing up
In the event that you spot the falling skies you might want to take the time to assemble the right gear. We suggest a hard hat, an oxygen mask, and a megaphone so you can warn anyone close by.

Step 1

Identify the falling sky

For some strange reason the pieces are hexagonal in shape and blend into the environment like a chameleon. Stare at the sky for 30 seconds then look at the white space below, you should see a glowing piece of the sky.



Step 5
Convince Others
To prove to the others that you are not making this up, finish this drawing to help them understand what is happening. Once you are done, chances are they'll believe you.

Step 6

Not look insane

As chaotic and overwhelming the responsibility of convincing others to believe you when you tell them the sky is falling, you have to maintain your wits. To do that, find the right words to say when blaring it out on the megaphone.
