

Instructions:

 Grab a parent, print out the pattern & pick a great pumpkin!
Cut out the top. Cut a 4-5 inch circular shape around the stem.
Be sure to include an extra notch so it's easier to put the lid back on the pumpkin. Be sure to cut at an angle so your lid doesn't fall in!
Remove the insides! Pull out the seeds and strings. Then scrape the inside walls of the pumpkin with a flat scooper or spoon. Make your walls smooth and clean.

4. Tape this pattern to the side of the pumpkin. Use a poking tool (always have adult supervision!) to poke tiny holes through the lines in the pattern at 1/4 inch intervals forming a "dot-to-dot" outline of Chicken Little. 5. When all the lines are poked remove the Chicken Little pattern. Save your pattern for reference! Carve your pumpkin following the patterns of dots! Light up your very own Chicken Little pumpkin!
