Under the Gun

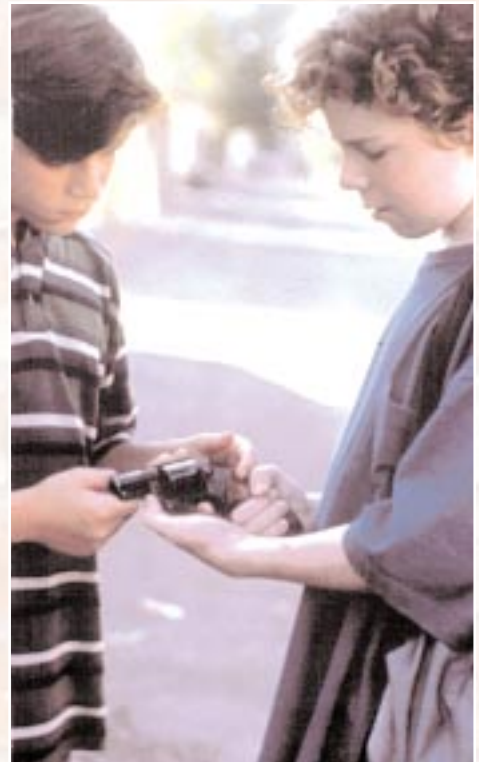
