



Sunflower Wind Streamer

Hang this sweet sunflower streamer outside and watch it wave in the warm summer breezes – or hang it on a door inside!

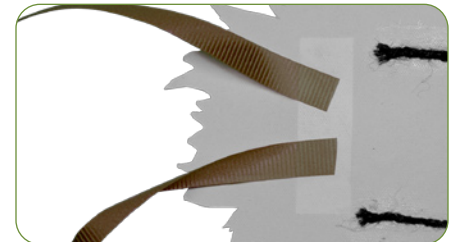
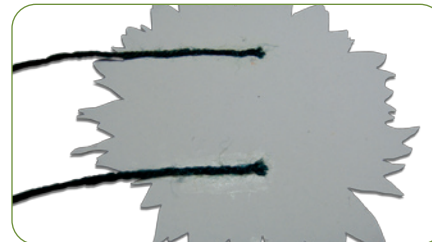


Things you need: Paper plate, scissors, glue, yarn or thin ribbon, and ribbons.



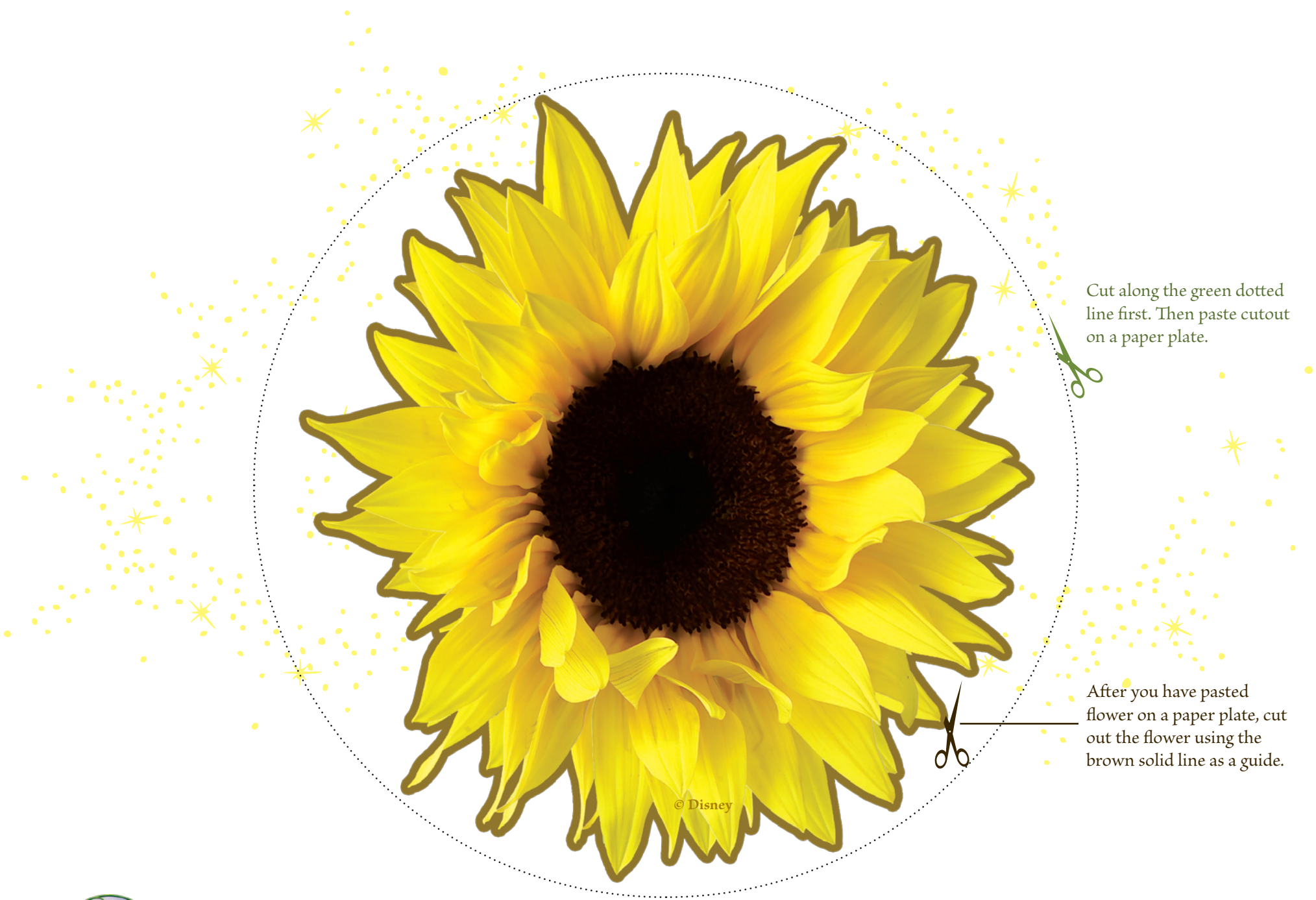
Instructions

1. Start by cutting out the sunflower on page two, using the green dotted line as a guide. Then paste flower on a paper plate.
2. Next, trim off the edge of the plate. Then cut out the flower using the brown solid line as a guide.
3. Attach a loop of thin ribbon or yarn to the back of the sunflower using tape (you'll use this as a hanger).
4. Finally, glue or tape on the ribbons (about 1.5 to 3 feet long each) so they fly from the bottom.
