## Turkey Tic-Tac-Toe



### Crayola Supplies

- Crayons (Regular)
- Model Magic®
- Washable Markers
- Scissors
- Glue Sticks

### Other Supplies

- construction paper

### Why?

Kids gobble up this new version of Tic-Tac-Toe. Creating a unique carry-all game board adds a feather to kids' caps.

### How?

1. Draw a turkey on construction paper with Crayola® Crayons. Cut it out with Crayola® Scissors.
2. Draw a tic-tac-toe grid of three rows and three columns of squares in the middle of the turkey. Decorate your turkey with features such as eyes and tail feathers with Crayola® Washable Markers.
3. Shape X and O game pieces with Crayola® Model Magic®. Dry.
4. Cut a construction paper square about as large as your turkey. Glue the sides and bottom to the back of your turkey with a Crayola® Glue Stick. Leave the top open so you can insert your game pieces.

## Interesting Information

If you enjoy playing Tic-Tac-Toe, try the opposite form of the game: Toe-Tac-Tic. The object is to NOT get three in a row. First player to get three in a row loses and the other player wins by default.

ATTENTION: The cutting edges of scissors are sharp and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling. Adult supervision is recommended with all children.

Model Magic® and other modeling compounds: Keep finished product away from open flame. Do not mold into candleholders or other like items for use around flame. Do not put in oven, microwave, or kiln.
