- 2. Mix different colors of Model Magic® to get piggy pink, duck-bill orange, and other farm-animal colors. Shape a small handful into a ball. Push it on one finger.
- 3. Roll tiny balls and coils of Model Magic to add a pig's curly tail or chick's beak. When Model Magic is fresh from the pack, it sticks to itself! Air-dry your puppets overnight. Your rooster will crow in the morning.
